Addenda to the Examination and Assessment Regulations for 2020-21

1. Progression and Award Regulations

Regulation 231 Repeat stages of study

The offer of a repeat undergraduate stage of study may be made at the Summer Progression and Award Board (PAB) where a choice of a repeat stage or resits may be given to students with fewer than 90 credits. A repeat stage may also be offered by the Resit PAB, following a resit opportunity.

2. Exceptional Circumstances

Regulation 14

Examples of inadmissible cases and evidence (no further opportunity to submit evidence will be given):

(vii) <u>Personal computer problem</u>, theft/loss, data loss and/or printer problems (students should ensure that work is backed up separately).

Remove (vii): a claim may be made related to access to IT or internet.

3. Students with a Declared Disability

An amendment was made to Annex A of the regulations regarding extra time for exams as a reasonable adjustment for students. Students with 50% additional time for exam modes will be given a further 15 minutes for resting in exams of less than 60 minutes.
