Grounded in a Bahaus approach to creative thinking, the Colour, Texture & Finish masterclass will explore the language of colour, facilitating personal design & development.

Her varied experience ranges from designing colour palettes for retail paint ranges for B&Q, to public collaborative art installations for a hospital corridor, as part of 'Enhancing the Healing Environment'. Teresa is the Co-director of Little & Collins who produce & design limited edition collections of handmade rugs & are a specialist textile design consultancy for furnishings and floorings.
