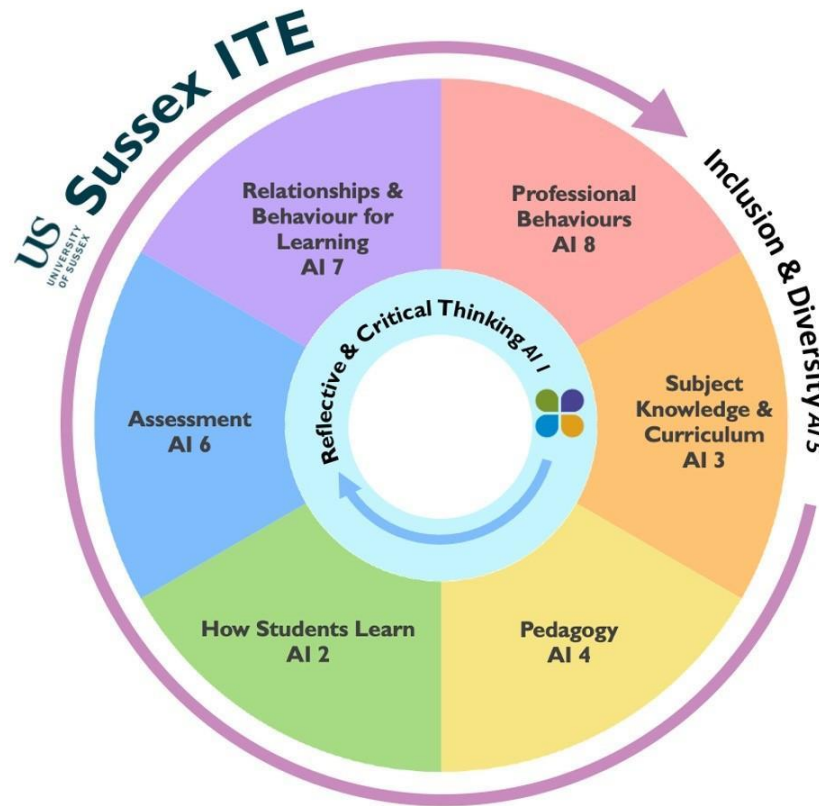


Secondary ITE Induction Programme 2023
