

Computing Facilities in Informatics

Students in Informatics have access to the department's specialist teaching labs in addition to the University's standard computing facilities. There are four main teaching labs in Informatics:

When these labs are not booked for classes they are available to Informatics students for private study.

Informatics students have access to a range of development tools and specialist software not available elsewhere on campus. Labs 1a, 1b and 3 are equipped with high-performance workstations fitted with nVidia Quadro professional graphics cards driving wide-screen monitors. This equipment is provided exclusively for students taking Informatics modules.

As the department's systems are built on top of the University's standard provision, new Informatics students should attend the introductory sessions run by IT Services during Induction Week.
