

DGN Batteries

Ni-Cd, mercury, and lead-acid batteries are all classified as hazardous waste and have to be disposed of separately from the main waste stream.

The University has a number of collection points around the campus where batteries can be deposited for disposal. The batteries are collected by the University waste contractor on a quarterly basis.
