

## **DGN Fluorescent Tubes**

Fluorescent tubes and sodium lamps contain small amounts of mercury which are harmful to human health and the environment. They are classified as hazardous waste and must be separated out from the main waste stream.

The University Estates and Facilities Management Division have a collection system in place. The contractor Lampcare collects the various tubes and lamps and ensures the recovery of the mercury and the recycling of glass aluminium and metals from lamps.
