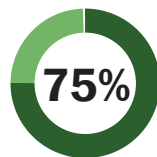
How do you get information about using IT at Sussex?

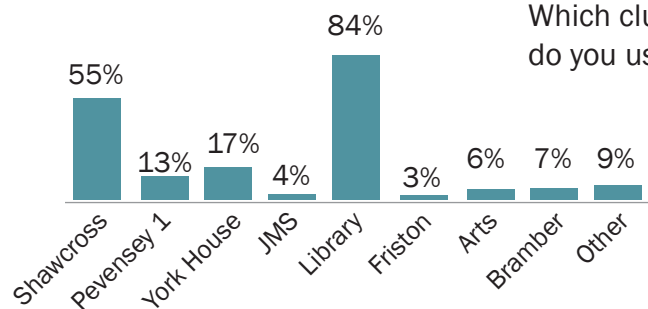

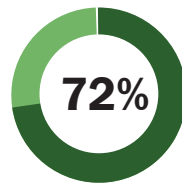

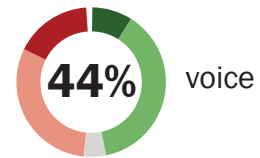


Which cluster rooms do you use?

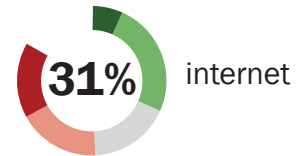
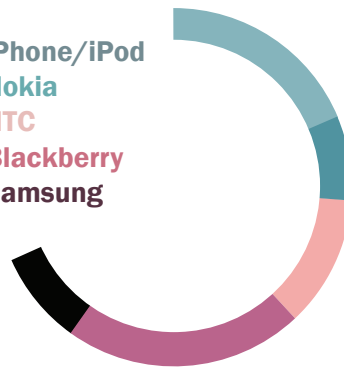

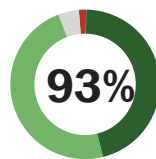
Satisfaction with reception on campus



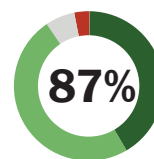

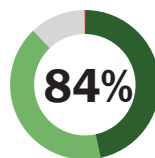


agree or strongly agree that Study Direct is easy to use

## Lecture capture

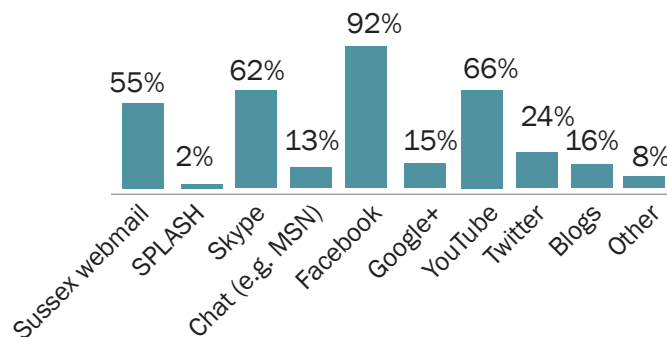


agree or strongly agree that lecture capture supports learning when it is used



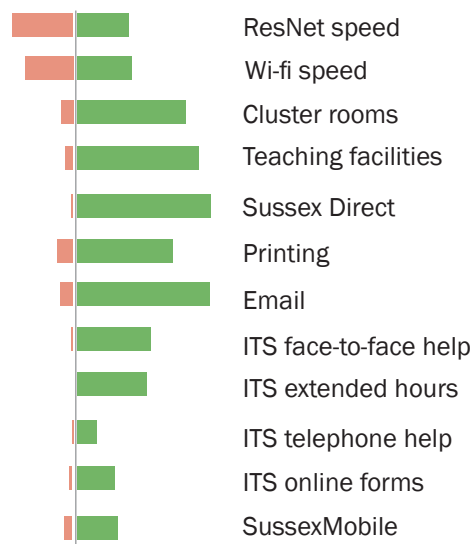
