


### **Academic Development - Summative Assessment**

All students take both AD1 (autumn) and AD2 (Spring) modules. During the course of the two modules you will be engaged in the process of researching and writing a discursive essay which will be developed and assessed in stages. The graphic shows the different AD assessments, with the arrows indicating the connection these assessments have with each other.

The 3 assessments connected to the Academic Writing Guide (AWG) plus the final essay are developed as part of a holistic writing process leading to the final essay, and it is important not to think of them as disconnected tasks.



## **Academic Development 1 - Autumn Term Assessment**

# a) Two reports showing you have engaged with and applied the lessons learned from the Academic Writing Guide (AWG)

- Written submission/project output AWG Stage 1 (Parts 1 & 2) & reflection 20% of module total submitted in week 5
- Written submission/project output AWG Stage 2 (Parts 1 & 2) & reflection 50% of module total submitted in week 11

### **b)** Assessed Presentation

 PPT slides presentation with audio – 30% of module total submitted in assessment period 1 (January)

# a) A draft of your essay showing you have engaged with and applied the lessons learned from the Academic Writing Guide (AWG)

#### b) The final version of your essay
