PASS	Demonstration of a sound understanding of the whole scenario. Demonstration of appropriate clinical examination and/or consultation skills AND Satisfactory interpretation of the information provided in the scenario AND appropriate communication with patient. All essential skills demonstrated. Minor inconsistencies or inaccuracies are permitted; however, safe practice must have been demonstrated throughout.
FAIL	Sound understanding of the scenario not demonstrated OR appropriate clinical examination and/or consultation skills not demonstrated OR unsatisfactory interpretation of the information provided in the scenario. Lack of appropriate communication with the patient. One or more essential skills not demonstrated. Major inconsistencies or inaccuracies demonstrated. Safe practice not demonstrated OR unsafe practice demonstrated.
