What's new?

- 2 weeks Easter holidays, late

Marks and attendance

- change modules – until **end of week 2**, school office
- **go to lectures**
- **hand in worksheets** – they count towards the final mark
- 24 hour late: -5%, after that 0
- **marks count** towards your degree: BSc weighting 40:60 (Year 2 and 3), MMath weighting 40:60:65 (Year 2, 3, and 4)
