He has published on the history of the Science Citation Index, on scientometrics, on the way the criteria of scientific quality have been changed by citation analysis. He has also published on e-science and e-research, open access to scientific data, virtual research environments and webometrics. He has edited a forthcoming volume "Virtual Knowledge" with MIT Press (2012). He is member of the editorial boards of the *Journal of the American Society for Science and Technology Studies, Social Studies of Science, Cybermetrics*, and the series *Scholarly Communication* with Brill Publishers.
