Key research question: How can legal and policy frameworks governing access to urban growing spaces contribute to community resilience capacities?


Socio-legal research.

- Informal/ extra-legal arrangements and relationships crucial, but could also lead to precarity and insecurity.
- Inequality of access limited the resilience benefits accessible to the most vulnerable communities.
