Eligibility criteria

In order to be considered for an Economic and Social Development Scholarship you must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Be a national from, and resident in, one of the following countries: India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka

Students currently studying in the UK (including as undergraduates at Sussex) are not eligible to apply.
2. Be applying for a **one-year Master's degree** in the following subject areas only:
 - Anthropology
 - Development Studies / International Development (including the Institute of Development Studies)
 - Economics
 - Education
 - Gender Studies
 - International Relations
 - Human Rights
 - Migration Studies
3. Not previously have studied at degree level in the UK.
4. Be classified to pay fees at the "overseas" (non-EU) rate.
5. Have sufficient funds to meet your tuition fees and living expenses, after taking account of the possible award of this Scholarship.
