







Koç University Center for Asian Studies (KUASIA) will grant one post-doctoral fellowship in Asian Studies in line with the Center's objectives. Candidates should have received their PhD either from social sciences and humanities or in administrative sciences at the time of their application for the position.

An academic focus on China and Southeast Asia is strongly desirable. Fellowships include stipend, health insurance and a research budget including travel. Fellows will be able to take advantage of the university facilities and all libraries connected to the university. Fellowships will be given for one year, renewable depending on the research project. KUASIA fellows are expected to run their own research project, to co-operate with the Center and partner universities in devising and applying for other projects, to give lectures and to participate in conferences/seminars/workshops organized by KUASIA, to write op-eds, articles and reports on their research.

The applications should be submitted to kuasia@ku.edu.tr no later than February 1st, 2018 and include a cover letter, a curriculum vitae with list of publications and other scholarly work, and a brief description of their research project.
