

## Information for Schools regarding Study Abroad 2021/22

Students were given the options set out below in relation to Study Abroad for 2021/22, due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

For students due to undertake a Year Abroad in 2021/22:

- Option 1:**      **Continue:** students choose to undertake a virtual (online) alternative offered by their host institutions for semester 1 or, where possible, modules offered by Sussex, followed by physical mobility in semester 2 (or whenever it becomes possible).
- Option 2:**      **Invert:** students choose to undertake their final year at Sussex in 2021/22 then undertake their Year Abroad in 2022/23.
- Option 3:**      **Cancel:** students choose to forego study abroad in 2021/22, and progress directly to their final year in 2021/22.

For students due to undertake a Year Abroad in 2021/22, who have already inverted in 2020/21:

- Option 1:**      **Graduate:** these students will have met all requirements for their three-year degree and will graduate at the end of 2020/21 with no further mitigation.

For students due to undertake a Semester Abroad in semester 1 one of 2021/22:

- Option 1:**      **Switch:** where possible, apply to move their Semester Abroad to the spring/summer semester instead.
- Option 2:**      **Cancel:** forego their study abroad semester. If students choose this, they would still have the option in 2022/23 to apply for a full additional Year Abroad.
