147	Addition of one-year Direct Entry/ final year entry degree to awards table	Reflect revisions to Sussex Academic Framework
148	Addition of provision for constructive knowledge of a disability for Direct Entry/ final year entry awards. Existing: <i>The PAB has the discretion to base final classification outcomes on the marks achieved during the stage or stages of study after reasonable support was put in place, following receipt of notification or constructive knowledge of a disability. No marks should be set aside and a minimum of a full stage of marks must be considered.</i> New addition: <i>For courses taken over a single stage of study, the PAB will be advised of cases where support was offered after the start of the course so that a sit may be considered for modules with impacted marks prior to when the support was offered. No marks can be set aside.</i>	Addition required for newly approved Direct Entry/ final year entry awards, replicating regulation for single-stage PGT awards.
