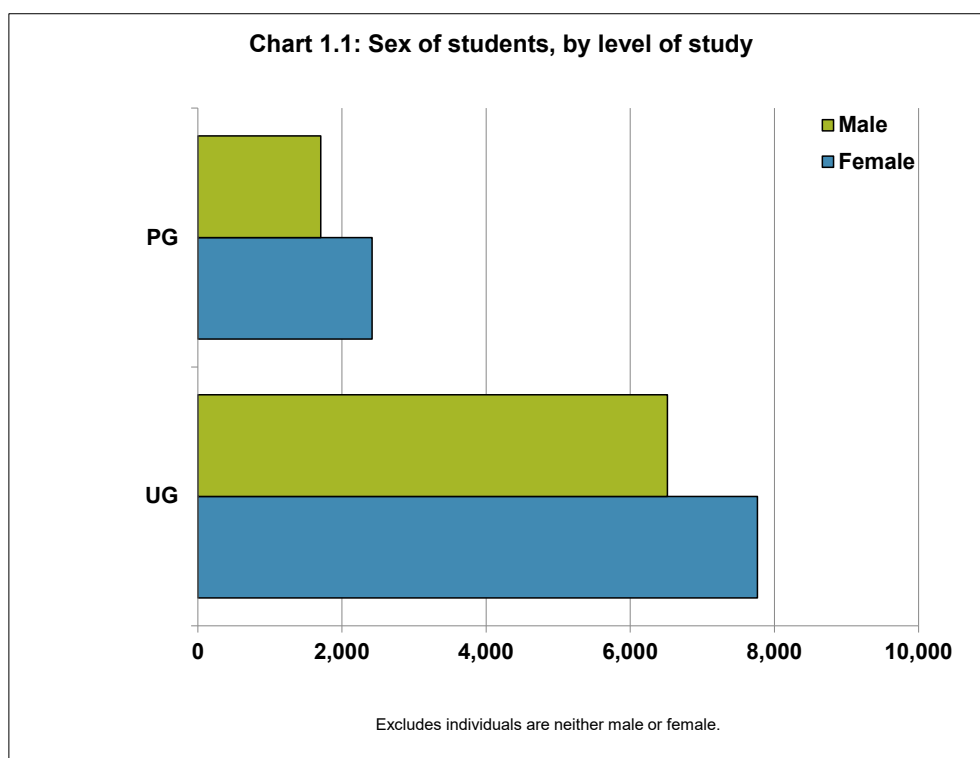

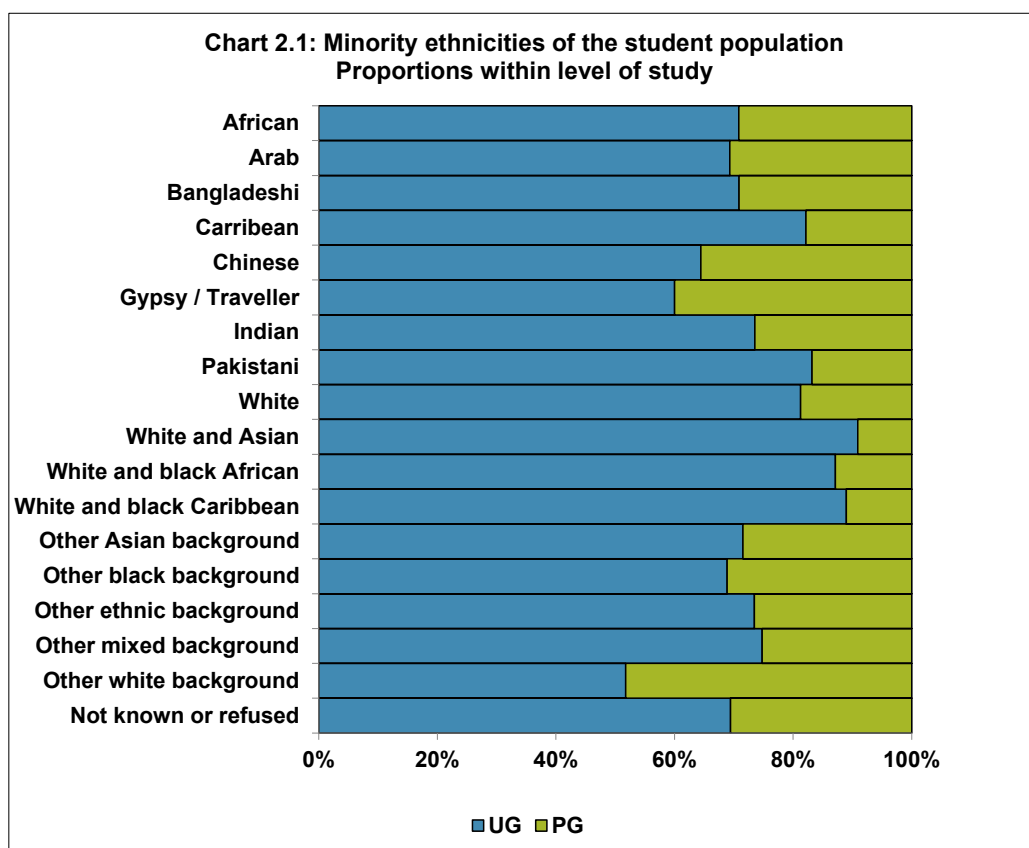

Proportions within year of known ethnicities**

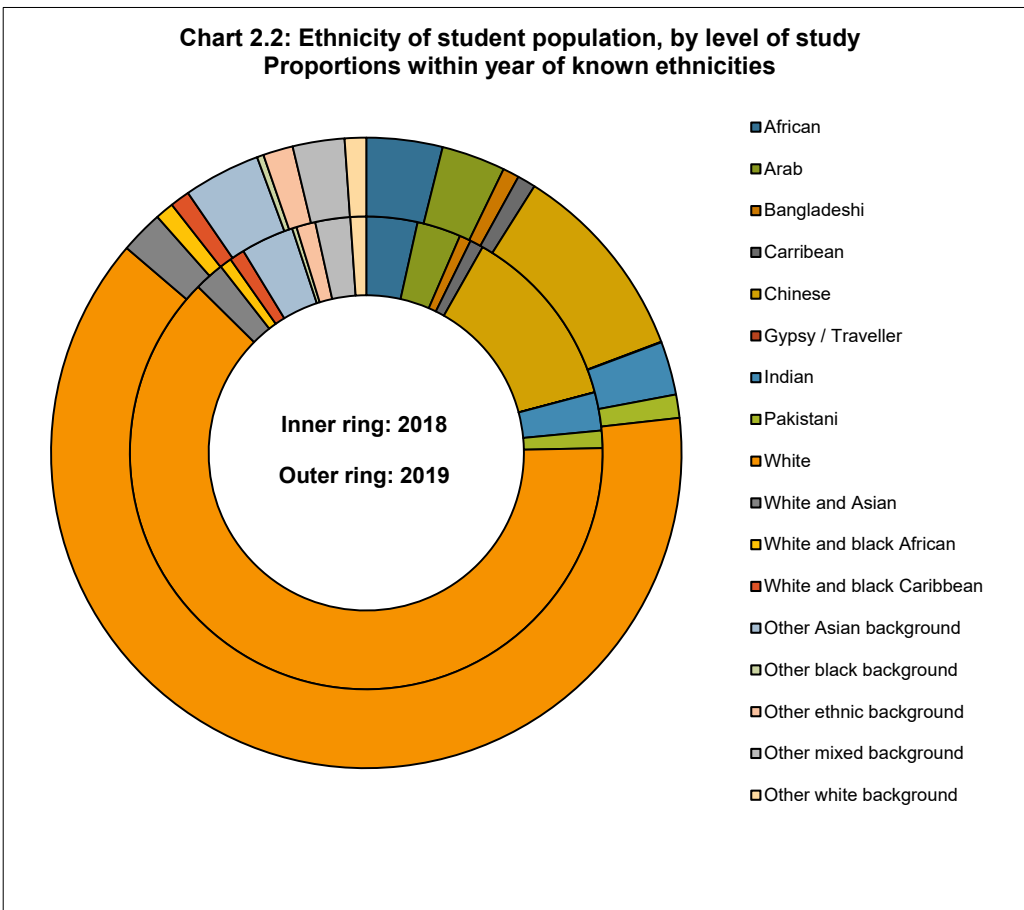

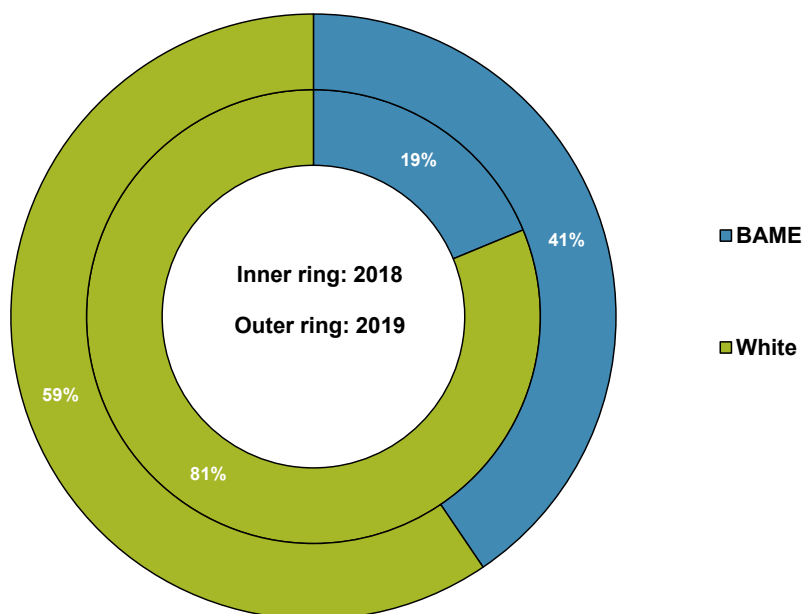

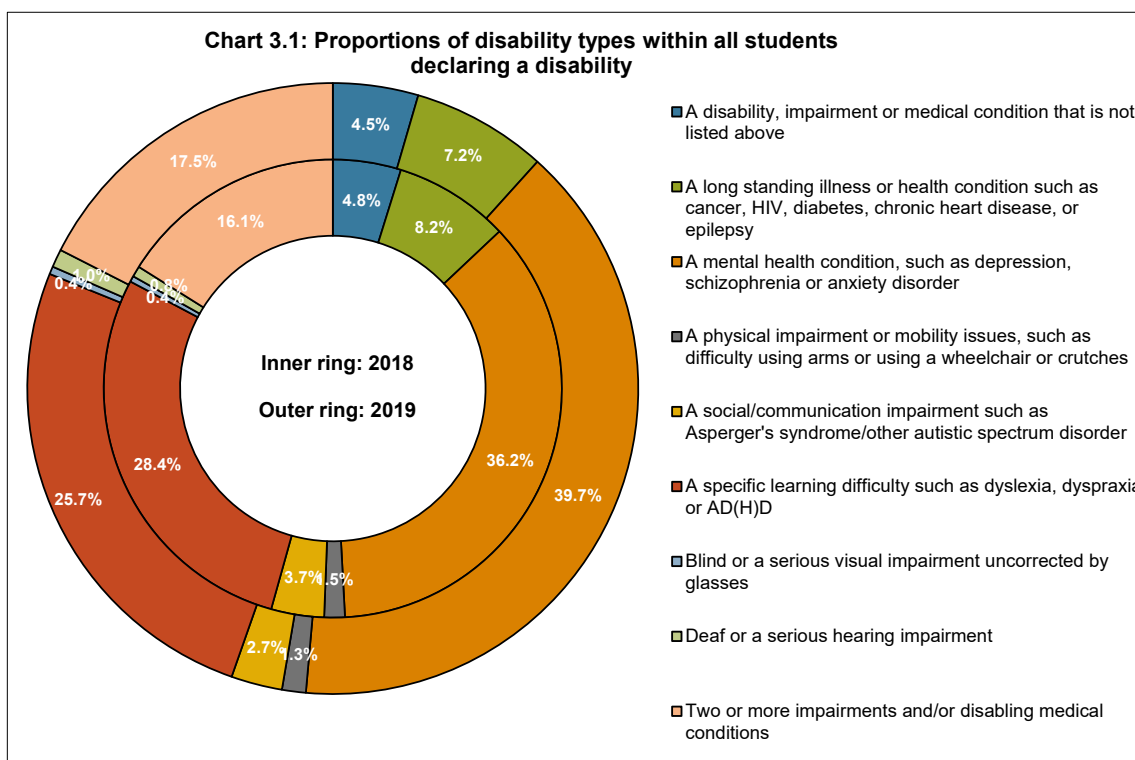

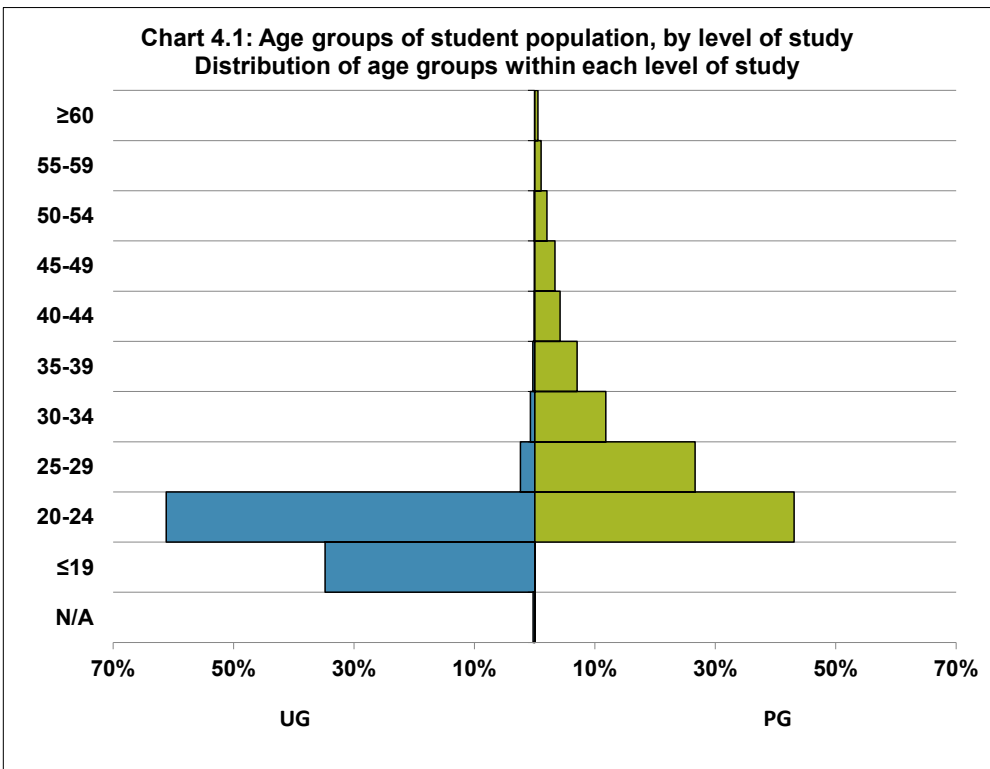
