This survey was carried out by Dr. Leonard, a Rural Sociologist. The field work was mostly carried out in January, February and March 1946, but data is presented on annual patterns.

Detailed data is presented for almost all the families in the sparsely populated area of Santa Cruz [a companion study to Leonard's previous work on Canton Chullpas]. Alongside photographs of rural life and farming practices, tables outline family size, structure, land held, debt and aspects of living conditions.
