Notes: A preliminary survey for the larger 1961 survey, this investigation was partly to test methodology. It focused on San José, and was carried out in October and November 1958. The intention was to update results from the 1948 survey, and to update the consumer price index. It was taken by the Department of Social Statistics. The geographical scope of this survey is greater than the 1948 one. No restriction on type of families.

Random sampling was attempted. The families surveyed were 5% of the total in the San José metropolitan area and were selected by grouping households according to income then selecting 30 households from each income group to survey in more detail.

Detailed data on income distribution by household is given, with very limited data on other matters such as expenditure or breakdown of income.
