## 1) Cuba, 1933 - 1934 (Academic - Individual, C.C. Zimmerman)

Survey ID: 169

113 households

Sample Duration: 1 Year(s)

**Notes:** In addition to providing sociological information on the structure and relations of Cuban families, this report by leading U.S. budget expert C.C. Zimmerman details the results of a household budget survey. The research was carried out between June 1933 and June 1934.

The sample was designed to be representative of the country, including a spread of families from different social strata and geographic regions.

Limited individual data on 41 households is presented, mostly concerned with the quality of diet. The data is mostly grouped, with comprehensive data on household incomes and expenditures, as well as capital holdings.

## 2) Cuba, 1938 - 1939 (Servicio Medico Social)

Survey ID: 170

2,903 households

Sample Duration: 1 Month(s)

**Notes:** This survey took place in May and October 1938; December 1938; May 1939; June and December 1939. Technically, it was three separate surveys within the time period, but since the data here is presented in aggregate form, it is impossible to differentiate between the surveys.

The purpose was to assess family living standards and nutritional provision, and mothers of households were asked to keep budget books.

Data is presented in three groups, organised by family size. Grouped average income and expenditure on food items, including quantities, is given.
