Selection: Dominican Republic.

1) Dominican Republic, 1941 - 1941 (Oficina Nacional de Estadística)

320 households

Sample Duration: 1 Month(s)

Notes: The first household survey in Dominican Republic, only for the city of Santo Domingo (Trujillo at that time) carried out by today's Oficina Nacional de Estadística.

Weights for a cost of living index were derived from a family living study covering 49 families, of 5 persons each, conducted during November 1941, with incomes up to \$30. However, the sample for the whole survey was of 320 families.

The objective of the of the survey was to obtain a consumption structure that would be the basis for estimating a cost of living index for the city of Santo Domingo.

3) **Dominican Republic, 1969 - 1969 (Banco Central de la Republica Dominicana and Oficina Nacional de Estadística)** Survey ID: 1456

552 households

Sample Duration: 1 Year(s)

Notes: An urban survey of 552 families, held in the capital Santo Domingo and conducted by a team of investigators supervising the keeping of budget books. The purpose was to develop a proper consumer price index, as the existing one was based on a 1941 survey. The data collection was funded by USAID. Survey was designed by CEPAL.

Comprehensive data on income and expenditure is presented in four volumes. The survey was conducted by the Banco Central de la Republica Dominicana and the Oficina Nacional de Estadística between January and December 1969 with the aim of determining the living conditions of families of salaried workers.

Stratified sampling on the basis the data from the 1960 Census. 606 families were chosen initially, 552 surveys were finally used.
