The criteria for the sample is summed up in the report as follows: 'African families of 2-8 persons at least one of whom was an adult female, with 1-3 incomes from all [i.e. any] sources, but with any wage income within the range £5-£15 a month, excluding families in villages on the outskirts of the urban area'. Although 15 items of expenditure were recorded, these are not reported by expenditure distribution - only the percentage proportion of food to overall expenditure is given within the distribution.
