**Notes:** This survey took place between 15 April 1967 and 14 April 1968, with the Honduras governmental statistical agency working in conjunction with the Ministry of Labour and ODECA [Organizacion de Estados Centroamericanos]. The central bank helped financially to pay for the enquiry.

Rural and urban households were selected for representativeness using the 1961 population census. Stratified random sampling was followed. 2158 surveys were distributed and data was obtained from 1760.

Comprehensive group data is presented, mostly organised by geographic area [Distrito Central, 343 households; San Pedro Sula, 225 households; other urban areas, 278 households; rural areas, 914 households] /urban and rural, although additionally broken down by income group and household composition. Food quantities consumed are also given.
