## 1) Leeward Islands, 1938 - 1939 (Foreign and Commonwealth Office)

**Notes:** A comprehensive agricultural survey presenting varied data collected over several years in different rural areas on the Leeward and Windward Islands [Leeward Islands for the purposes of this report being Antigua, St. Kitts, Nevis and the Windward Islands Grenada, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and Dominica]. The survey-takers express a concern about the relative decline in productivity of the British West Indies compared to other areas of the British Empire. The long-term stated aim was to encourage self-sufficient, efficient and profitable forms of agriculture.

Data is often presented by region, and by type of landholding. It includes data on land, education levels, agricultural practices and food consumption.

The specific survey of 359 households' income took place in 1938/39 in Low Ground [Nevis], Hamilton [Nevis], Belmont [St. Vincent], Park Hill [St. Vincent] and Three Rivers [St. Vincent].
