Notes: Objectives: to study the state of health of certain groups of people; to show how this is affected by diet; to define factors which determine diet.

Survey of 3 occupational groups in lower income levels:

- 1) community employed in smallholder agriculture on coastal plain of Malacca: 50 households
- 2) community employed in fishing not far away from group 1: 37 households
- 3) community employed as labour in rubber estate: 39 households

Each group was surveyed for 2 months in 1948.

Selection of households at random.
