Notes: Family budget survey conducted in October 1953 by the Direccion General de Estadistica y Censos of 543 rural and urban families. Families of industrial workers, rural day labourers, craftsmen and small farmers were considered.

The objective was twofold. First to gather information so that the government can guide the nation to solve its socio-economic problems. Also the aim was to elaborate a cost of living index.

To elaborate the cost of living, the sample was narrowed to the industrial workers' families in Managua.

The next survey was carried out between May and October 1972
