Survey was carried out througout a year but questions were asked in 4 different months (March, June, September, December), regarding the previous period (February, May, August, November).

Data is presented by household and in some cases by members of the family.

Stratified sampling was used based on the data obtained from the 1960 population census.

Survey analysed the distribution of expenditures, and the uses of the monies, estimating savings/debts.
