Notes: This is an agricultural sociological study, undertaken mainly to assess the deficiencies in the Paraguayan diet, and determine how those deficiencies could be improved with agricultural policy.

Information was gathered by interview method and observation of household practices and family life.

Detailed sociological, anthropomorphic, housing and dietary data including food quantity is given for 56 households, and in addition budget information is given for 11 households.

4) **Paraguay, 1963 - 1964 (Private - Group, I.L.O.)**

Sample Duration: 5 Month(s)

Notes: The first significant survey in Paraguay, this was conducted by the International Labour Organisation for the purposes of developing a consumer price index. It was undertaken in conjunction with the Banco Central de Paraguay.

Budgetary investigations of 791 working class urban households in the five main cities were undertaken with a combination of budget book and interview during the months of August and November 1963, and then in February, May and August 1964. Probabilistic sampling was followed on the basis of the 1962 population census. Data for 671 families exists.

Grouped data on household composition, income and expenditure is presented by city, along with the ensuing CPI calculations
