Notes: In the tradition of LePlay, and with the organising concept of the family as a unit of society, Lavalle and Garcia sought to investigate the cost and standard of living of 17 working class families in Lima in 1918.

Individual data on the composition, wages, living conditions of these families is given in textual form.

Sample Duration: 1 Year(s)

Notes: A comprehensive government-run survey, which reflects on the tradition of household budget surveys established by Eden, Engel, Le Play etc and was additionally influenced by similar surveys in other Latin American countries. Survey of 81 families living in the city of Lima. Data was collected during the first week of November 1940. Surveyors had a list of families to visit and they visited 2/3 families. No information as to how that initial list was elaborated is provided.

Working class households were selected, and data is presented by family size, occupation of head of household and income group. There was a particular concern for nutrition, and information on food consumption is presented. Detailed group data is given.

Data given is grouped calorie intake information on a typical daily diet, with some additional breakdown on food consumption. Limited income and anthropomorphic data is presented.

Information was collected on housing, population, migration, educacion, economically active population, labour market, income, ocupational mobility.

Probabilistic sampling was carried out. The survey was carried out in stages using stratified sampling.

It was based on the previous survey experiences in the cities of Arequipa and Iquitos that were similar to it. As such, it was a very ample survey that aimed to collect information on internal migration, education, employment, demography, housing, occupational mobility and income.

Probabilistic sampling was used, based on the 1961 survey data. Interviews of individuals over 12 years of wage were also carried out.
