Survey of 81 families living in the city of Lima. Data was collected during the first week of November 1940. Surveyors had a list of families to visit and they visited 2/3 families. No information as to how that initial list was elaborated is provided.

Working class households were selected, and data is presented by family size, occupation of head of household and income group. There was a particular concern for nutrition, and information on food consumption is presented. Detailed group data is given.
