Those of wage-earners were represented by unskilled workers (coolies) with a monthly wage not exceeding 15 piastres per month.

**Notes:** Family expenditure survey conducted in 1963 by means of questionnaires addressed to 900 wage earners' households in Saigon; the replies of about 300 households were retained.

In 1963, the National Institute of Statistics (NIS) conducted an expenditure survey of family budgets in Saigon, Dalat, and seven other provinces. This survey was designed to collect and record data on general living conditions and allocation of family income among alternative expenditures.

The methodology applied by NIS was families from selected social classes in different in alternate periods. The survey lasted one year, periods, each period was of three months duration.

The questionnaire was constructed so as to obtain information covering daily, weekly, and monthly expenses.

Sample Duration: 1 Year(s)

Notes: Rural Income and Expenditure Sample Survey of Vietnam of 1964, sponsored by the Agency for International Development and directed by Stroup.

This survey covered 2,910 households selected as random samples of thirty in each of ninety-seven hamlets from thirty-two of the thirty-nine provinces of Vietnam. Cash holdings and savings were included in the income and expenditure information obtained from each household.

For survey purposes the country was divided into three regions- South Vietnam West, which encompasses the Mekong Delta; South Vietnam East, which includes the Saigon River Delta and the plains north and west of Saigon; and South Vietnam Central, which is made up of the nine coastal lowland provinces extending from Binh Thuan Province to the seventeenth parallel.

First known attempt to secure basic data of income and expenditure patterns which would be broadly representative of the rural Vietnamese population.

Immediate purpose: establish consumer income-expenditure patterns in the rural areas of Vietnam.

Field work was done during the months of June and July 1964. Most of the data were recorded on an annual basis and therefore the period covered is from June 1963 to June 1964.
