Dear Colleagues,

After the cancellation of the 2020 edition of the CALOR conference, we are pleased to announce that the 19th International Conference on Calorimetry in High Energy Physics (CALOR2022) will take place at the University of Sussex (Brighton, UK) from the 16th to the 20th of May 2022.

The Website for the conference is at <https://www.sussex.ac.uk/physics/research/calor2022> where you can find all information about how to get to the University of Sussex, accommodation, how to register to the conference, and the programme (with a link where to submit abstracts).

Registration is already open. We ask all participants (and guests) to register by the 13th of April in order to be charged 'early' registration fees. We will not be able to accept payments at the conference, so we would like to ask all participants (and guests) to pay for the conference fees using the University of Sussex online Shop page linked to the Registration page. Given the current pandemic situation, we will run the conference in a 'mixed' mode ('in person' and 'online'). Participants who want to register for 'online' participation only, can indicate so on the registration form. Fees for 'online only' participation is £20.

For participants who need to apply for a Visa to travel to the UK, there are information on the conference page on how to request an invitation letter; please contact us (Fabrizio Salvatore at p.f.salvatore@sussex.ac.uk and Sinead Rance/Alex Ferrari at mpsresearchsupport@sussex.ac.uk) as soon as possible, so that we can help as much as we can with the process.
