## **Public Transport**

The University of Sussex has excellent public transport links. Falmer rail station is on the edge of campus, and the number 25 bus from Brighton is every 5-10 minutes, stopping on North-South Road just outside the science buildings.

## Car or Minibus

If you plan to travel by car or minibus, please **aim for Car Park 1** (**postcode BN1 9RQ**) to the east of campus. It is a large car park, and is a 10 minute walk away from the majority of the academic buildings. Parking on campus is free after 5pm.

## Coach

When travelling to campus by coach use the **postcode BN1 9QH**. Make sure that you **head north up North-South Road**, and drop off students at the bus stop - unloading a coach on the south bound is not safe. Unfortunately, there is currently nowhere on campus for large coaches to park, so we recommend parking in the large layby along the A27 towards Lewes instead.
