



SHL 2023 call for proposals: Terms and Conditions of award

Congratulations on securing SHL funding for your research and scholarly activities. We look forward to supporting and promoting your work.

This document sets out the general expectations from all SHL award holders. Use and management of the funds should follow the [University Financial regulations and policies](#) .

Specific conditions and timings of deliverables for grantees of SHL call for proposals 2023:

- 1- By end September 2023: produce a one-page report of how the funds have been spent, demonstrating, or illustrating how it has helped further the work towards a proposal for external funding.
- 2- A draft proposal or fully fledged concept note must be ready to be presented as part of the SHL Autumn Symposium 2023 (date tbc).
- 3- By end of 2023: a blog post for the SHL research blog to be submitted to shl@sussex.ac.uk
- 4- Grant submissions which arise from this engagement should be flagged as an SHL bid.

Contribution to SHL's future sustainability:

- You will be expected to organise a meeting with SHL Programme Manager to follow up on future bid plans.
- Please flag your bid(s) and if successful your award(s) as SHL activity.
- Inform us of any success, or impacts arising from your SHL funding.

Advocacy expectations:

- Acknowledge the support received from SHL in any form of media communication, conferences and all activities related to or resulting from the award.
- Credit SHL on outputs with the words 'Supported by Sussex Humanities Lab'.
- Tag SHL in social media (@SussexHumsLab).
