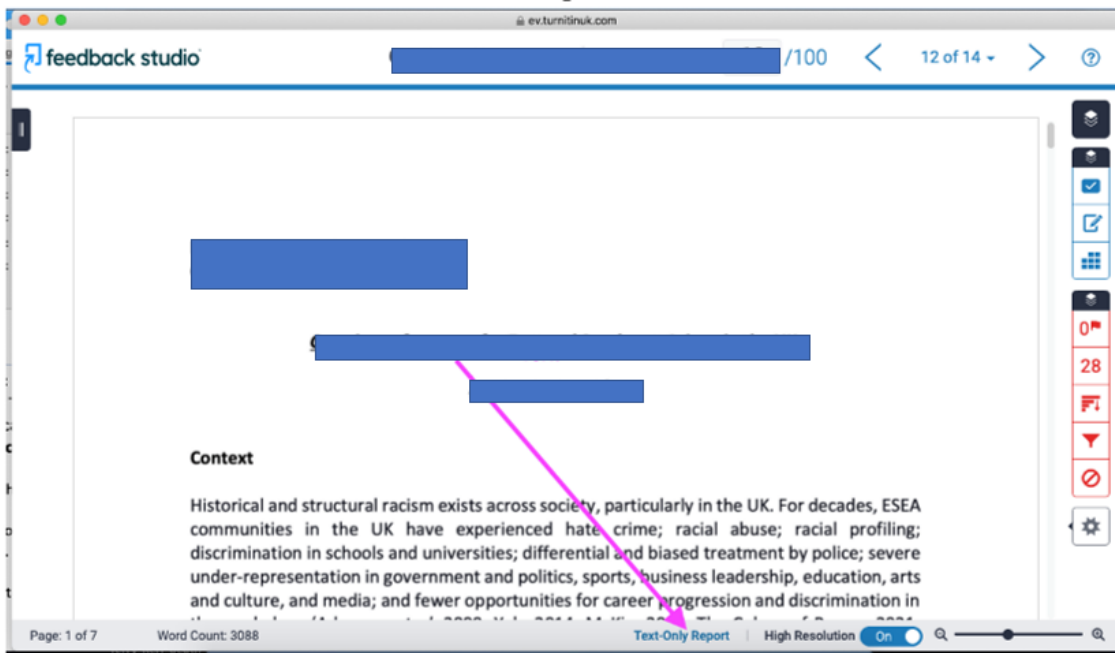


FINDING THE TURNITIN ORIGINALITY REPORT IN TURNITIN FEEDBACK STUDIO

1. Navigate to the assessment on Canvas
2. Click on the student submission
3. In Feedback Studio click 'Text-Only Report' (as shown below).
