

General Waste



✓ PLEASE USE FOR:

- food contaminated items
- chewing gum
- contaminated packaging
- anything else that cannot be recycled

✗ PLEASE DON'T USE FOR:

- aerosol cans
- batteries
- toners
- electrical items - contact your porter to dispose of these properly

Dry Mixed Recycling



✓ PLEASE USE FOR:

- plastic (bottles only)
- cardboard
- tin and other metal cans
- newspaper and office paper

✗ PLEASE DON'T USE FOR:

- shredded paper
- Tetrapak cartons
- empty plastic containers
- crisp and sweet wrappers
- tissues, handtowels, and napkins



WHERE POSSIBLE, PLEASE CLEAN ITEMS BEFORE BINNING THEM AS FOOD AND LIQUID WILL REDUCE THE AMOUNT WE CAN RECYCLE

Glass



✓ PLEASE USE FOR:

- glass bottles, cups and jars
- any other glass that has been emptied and cleaned of any food or liquids

✗ PLEASE DON'T USE FOR:

- laboratory glass
- ceramics



PLEASE DO NOT THROW PLASTIC BAGS IN THIS BIN, AS IT WILL CONTAMINATE THE GLASS RECYCLING

Food Waste



✓ PLEASE USE FOR:

- sandwiches
- fruit and vegetables
- teabags
- meat and fish scraps
- plate scrapings
- any other food items

✗ PLEASE DON'T USE FOR:

- bones - please remove first
- food packaging
- plates
- cutlery
- plastic bags - please use compostable bin liners only
- other non-food items

If you aren't sure about whether your waste can be recycled, dispose of it in general waste. Disposing of waste in the wrong bin risks contaminating recycling. **If in doubt, leave it out!**
