UNION BLACK

WHAT IS THE COURSE?

Union Black is an online course produced and hosted by the Open University on the social learning platform FutureLearn, in collaboration with Santander. Sussex is taking part in a pilot of Union Black, along with a number of other universities in the UK. This is an opportunity for Sussex staff and students to feed back to the OU on the content and shape the finished version.

Santander tell us that the course has been written in response to Universities UK's "Tackling racial harassment in higher education" report which shone a stark light on the racial inequalities that exist across the higher education sector.

The report called on universities to improve racial literacy among senior leaders, staff and students and issued a set of recommendations for institutions to implement including "training developed from an anti-racist perspective". The whole course takes about six hours in total (you can complete it in sections) and it can be completed anywhere with online access.

HOW DO I ACCESS THE COURSE?

The course is now available to staff and students at all UK universities. [Access to the course is via the Santander Scholarship platform](#). Once you have registered you will receive an email from FutureLearn with the link to access the course within 24 hours.
