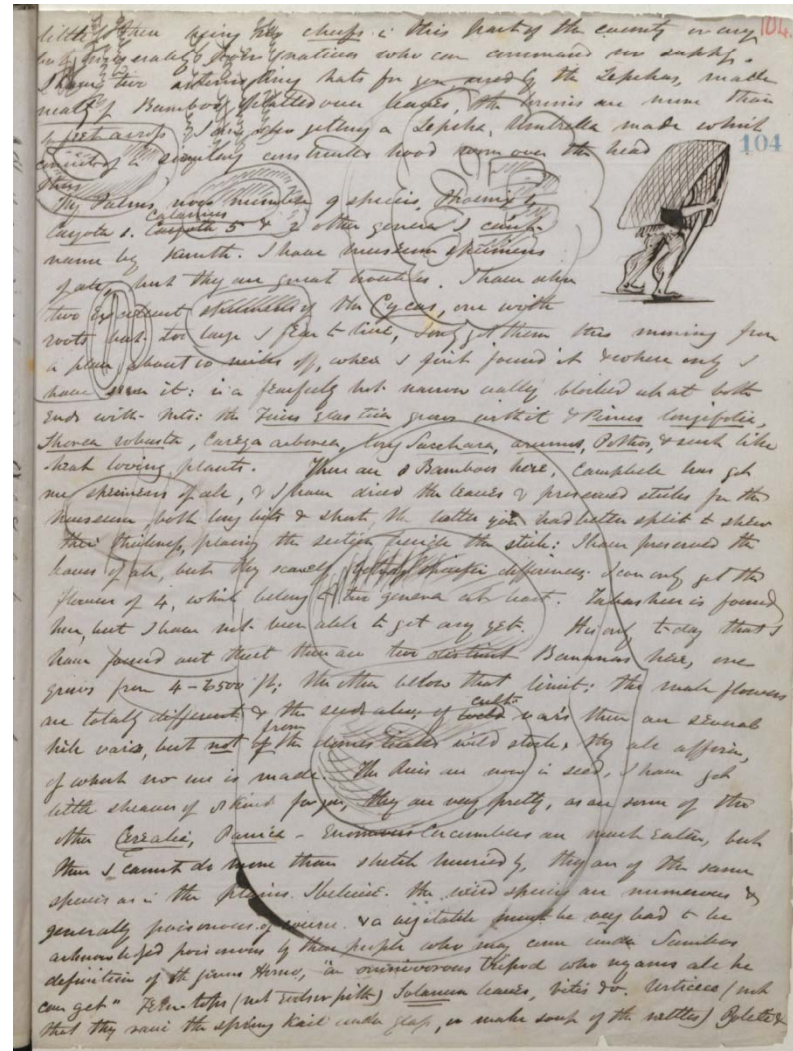

Producing a high-quality digital edition

- Hooker (1817-1911) was Director of Kew Gardens (1865-1885)
- His correspondence from his Himalayan expedition includes letters to:
 - Charles Darwin
 - Nathaniel Wallich
 - George Bentham
- The digital edition will be:
 - Encoded in TEI-compliant xml
 - Fully searchable by: plant and animal family, species, and genus; country; and personal names.



Matching collections and correspondence



The digital edition will provide a link between Hooker's correspondence, physical objects in the **economic botany collection** like these poisoned arrows from Bangladesh and **herbarium specimens** like this *Acer campbelli*, collected in Sikkim
