



**In memory of Nicola Anderson, a
Sussex student in the 1970s**

Open to all 2nd year anthropology and international
development students to fund travel during the summer
vacation

Who can apply?

The bursary is open to any student in their current second year in anthropology or international development (single or joint honors). Students will normally apply as individuals, although they may apply as a pair or small group.

How much money is available?

Usually around £2000 per year

What sort of project is funded?

It is expected that the bursary will be used for projects taking place in the summer vacation between students' second and third year. The bursary can be used to fund an independent project, research for a 3rd year thesis, and placement expenses.

How do selectors decide which project to fund?

Selection will be made by a panel of faculty members.

Selectors will draw up a shortlist, based on application forms.

There may be interviews or presentations, depending on quantity and quality of applications

It is assumed that applicants will need to provide some money for themselves, and be able to indicate how this will be raised.

Examples of past projects include:

- Rwandan Youth Information Community Organisation
- Research into fertiliser use in Tanzania
- Football and AIDS education in Zanzibar
- Photo project in Cambodia
