

## Learning Support Plan for all students registered with Disability Advice

Students who are flagged in 'green' on Sussex Direct have a learning support package in place from Disability Advice. This is comprised of the following reasonable adjustments:

- Penalty Waiver (automated via system selection)
- Student may request extensions to deadlines, 24-hour or 7-day (automated via system selection)
- 25% extra time in exams (automated via system selection)
- 15-minute rest break in exams, to be taken outside of the room and within the first hour if required
- In-person exams scheduled in a small group room
- 4-hour take-away paper (TAP) extensions
- Teaching materials including lecture outlines, power point presentations etc. to be provided 24 hours in advance of classes
- Provision of lecture videos
- Breaks from teaching sessions as needed
- Use of audio recorder in teaching sessions – must discuss with tutor
- Flexible and supportive response to disability-related absences
- Extended Library loans
- Use of study support room in the Library

Students receiving this package of support *will not* have further tutor awareness information on Sussex Direct. For information on the likely impact of a student's condition(s) on their learning, please see [guidance notes](#).

Students with complex, multiple, or fluctuating health conditions are likely to have an enhanced learning support plan containing information on the impact of their specific condition(s) on their learning. This document will be available via Sussex Direct.
