

Transfer of Occupational Health Records

After a thorough and competitive tendering exercise, the University has appointed Heales Medical to provide Occupational Health services to the University from 1 August 2019. The Occupational Health service will continue to be provided on the University campus. The University is working with Heales Medical and the current provider, Robens, to ensure a smooth transition.

Heales Medical are a specialist Occupational Health provider with considerable experience of delivering Occupational Health Services to a range of organisations.

As part of the transfer of the service, Robens will be transferring all Occupational Health records they hold for University staff and former staff to Heales Medical. This includes, for example, records relating to pre-employment health questionnaires, management referrals, staff self-referrals and health surveillance. As these records usually have to be kept for six years (or longer in the case of health surveillance records), the transfer will include records for former staff of the University.

Heales Medical will keep all personal data secure and confidential in accordance with Data Protection legislation.

The Data Protection Officer can advise on your rights under Data Protection legislation, including whether you can request the erasure of your Occupational Health records.
