For school groups visiting the University of Sussex for outreach events




Public Transport

The University of Sussex has excellent public transport links. Falmer rail station is on the edge of campus, and the number 25 bus from Brighton is every 5-10 minutes, stopping on North-South Road just outside the science buildings.

If you do plan to travel by public transport, please let us know in advance and we can meet you at the train station or the North-South Road bus stop.

Minibus

If you plan to travel by minibus, please **aim for Car Park 1** (use **postcode BN1 9RQ**) to the east of campus. Please phone us on arrival, and we can meet you in the car park with a parking permit – it is *always* easier (and safer) for us to find you in the car park and guide you to where you need to be.



Coach

When travelling to campus by coach use the **postcode BN1 9QH**. Make sure that you **head north up North-South Road**, and drop off students at the bus stop - unloading a coach on the south bound is not safe. Unfortunately, there is currently nowhere on campus for large coaches to park, so we recommend parking in the large layby along the A27 towards Lewes instead.

Car

We encourage you not to travel by car, since parking spaces are at a premium. If you do, please park in **Car Park 1** to the east of campus where parking costs £2.50 for 2 hours between 9am-5pm Monday to Friday. Only in exceptional circumstances can we cover parking costs, as we simply cannot afford to pay for all our visitors (over 4,000 each year, not including school groups!) to park.
