- By choosing digital print technology we have reduced waste and eliminated the use of chemicals and ink associated with lithographic printing
- All our waste paper and used toner cartridges are recycled
- Internal deliveries are made using SEF's Green smart electric van

- Our digital presses carry the Energy Star badge for energy efficiency
- All our standard papers are certified by the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) or the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC), or carry the EU Ecolabel, indicating that they are sustainably sourced and meet a set of environmental standards specified by the relevant body.
- All our external partners carry both ISO 14001 environmental accreditation and are FSC-certified.
