

Evolution of treatment for HIV infection










People living with HIV aged 50+ globally

People aged 50+ living with HIV










Age-related chronic diseases rises exponentially with age




Burden of NCD globally and by SSA region: 2017

Zambia (2018)

1.2m people living with HIV

11.3% adult HIV prevalence (ages 15-49)

48,000 new HIV infections

17,000 AIDS-related deaths

78% adults on antiretroviral treatment*

79% children on antiretroviral treatment*






